A BILL

To prohibit Federal agencies from purchasing or leasing new vehicles that are not zero-emission vehicles, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Green Federal Fleet
- 5 Act".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON THE PURCHASE OR LEASE OF VE-
2	HICLES THAT ARE NOT ZERO-EMISSIONS VE-
3	HICLES BY FEDERAL AGENCIES.
4	(a) Prohibition.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
5	sion of law, except as provided in paragraph (2), the head
6	of a Federal agency may not purchase or lease a non-tac-
7	tical passenger vehicle from a non-Federal entity unless
8	that vehicle is a zero-emission vehicle.
9	(b) Exemption.—The head of a Federal agency may
10	purchase or lease a non-tactical passenger vehicle from a
11	non-Federal entity that is not a zero-emission vehicle if
12	the head determines that, with respect to a particular cir-
13	cumstance, using a zero-emission vehicle will not be tech-
14	nically feasible.
15	(c) APPLICATION.—The prohibition established under
16	subsection (a) shall not apply with respect to purchases
17	made and leases entered into before the date of the enact-
18	ment of this Act.
19	(d) Definitions.—In this Act:
20	(1) Zero-emission vehicle.—The term "zero-
21	emission vehicle" means a passenger vehicle that
22	produces zero exhaust emissions of any criteria pol-
23	lutant, precursor pollutant, or greenhouse gas, other
24	than water vapor, in any mode of operation or condi-
25	tion, as determined by the Administrator of the En-
26	vironmental Protection Agency.

1	(2) FEDERAL AGENCY.—The term "Federal
2	Agency' means an establishment in the legislative,
3	judicial, or executive branch of the Federal Govern-
4	ment.
