# A BILL

To amend the VOW to Hire Heroes Act of 2011 to extend the Veterans Retraining Assistance Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Help Hire Our Heroes  
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF VETERANS RETRAINING ASSIST-**  
2 **ANCE PROGRAM.**

3 Section 211 of the VOW to Hire Heroes Act of 2011  
4 (Public Law 112–56; 38 U.S.C. 4100 note) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a)(2)(B), by striking “March  
6 31, 2014” and inserting “on the date that is 180  
7 days after the date of the enactment of the Help  
8 Hire Our Heroes Act”; and

9 (2) in subsection (k), by striking “March 31,  
10 2014” and inserting “on the date that is 180 days  
11 after the date of the enactment of the Help Hire  
12 Our Heroes Act”.

13 **SEC. 3. TRANSFER FROM LEAKING UNDERGROUND STOR-**  
14 **AGE TANK TRUST FUND TO VETERANS RE-**  
15 **TRAINING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.**

16 Subsection (c) of section 9508 of the Internal Rev-  
17 enue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end the  
18 following new paragraph:

19 “(3) TRANSFER TO DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS  
20 AFFAIRS.—Out of amounts in the Leaking Under-  
21 ground Storage Tank Trust Fund there is hereby  
22 appropriated \$270,000,000 to be transferred to the  
23 ‘Veterans Benefits Administration—Readjustment  
24 Benefits’ account of the Department of Veterans Af-  
25 fairs for the Veterans Retraining Assistance Pro-  
26 gram under section 211 of the VOW to Hire Heroes

1 Act of 2011 (Public Law 112–56; 38 U.S.C. 4100  
2 note), to remain available until expended.”.
