To apply for your U.S. passport, you must:

- Submit your completed application, DS-11, to request the Passport Book, Passport Card, or both, or submit the Renewal form, DS-82, to renew your passport (see form DS-82 to determine whether you're eligible to renew that way). The applications forms DS-11 and DS-82 can be downloaded from our website travel.state.gov
- Submit your evidence of U.S. citizenship:
A certified copy of your birth certificate;
An original Certificate of Naturalization or Citizenship;
Original Report of Birth Abroad; or
Previously issued, undamaged, U.S. passport.
(All original documents will be mailed back to customers at the end of the process*)
- Submit one recent Passport Photo – 2x2 (please note: **no glasses** in passport photos)
- Present Valid Photo Identification – Driver's License, State ID Card, current Passport or Military ID **and** submit a photocopy of the front & back of that ID
- Payment of passport fee **by credit card, or check or money order** payable to "US Dept of State". Please see the reverse side of this flyer for fee information. **We cannot accept cash.**

U.S. Passport Book: Valid for international travel by air, sea, and land.

U.S. Passport Card: Valid when entering the U.S. from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean and Bermuda at land or sea ports-of-entry. **Not valid for international travel by air.**

Validity of Books or Cards: 10 years for adults (age 16 & older)
5 years for minors (under age 16)

***With Routine Processing, your application will be processed within six weeks.
Expedited Processing (within three weeks) is available for an additional \$60 Fee.**

Passport applicants must appear in person, including minors. Passport applications for minors under 16 require the consent of *both* parents, or evidence that one parent has sole legal custody. **If you have international travel in less than two weeks, you are eligible to schedule an appointment at one of our 25 Passport Agencies open to the public in the United States. If you apply at a Passport Agency, you must provide proof of travel and you will be charged an additional \$60 expedite fee. Expedited service at an Agency is three days or less.*
