SEC. 2. INCREASE OF MAXIMUM AGE FOR CHILDREN ELIGI BLE FOR MEDICAL CARE UNDER CHAMPVA PROGRAM.

4 (a) INCREASE.—Subsection (c) of section 1781 of
5 title 38, United States Code, is amended to read as fol6 lows:

7 "(c)(1) Notwithstanding clauses (i) and (iii) of sec8 tion 101(4)(A) of this title and except as provided in para9 graph (2), for purposes of this section, a child is eligible
10 for benefits under subsection (a) until the child's 26th
11 birthday, regardless of the child's marital status.

"(2) This subsection shall not be construed to limit
eligibility for benefits under subsection (a) of a child described in section 101(4)(A)(ii) of this title.".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Such subsection, as so
amended, shall apply with respect to medical care provided
on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
