5 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 6 months after the date 6 of the adoption of this resolution, the Chief Administrative 7 Officer shall submit to the Committee on House Adminis-8 tration of the House of Representatives, and make avail-9 able to the public, a report that details the findings of 10 the study described in subsection (a).

(c) COVERED PROVIDER DEFINED.—In this section,
the term "covered provider" means an entity that provides
a live broadcast of floor proceedings of the House of Representatives to viewers.
