A BILL

To prohibit the sale of a firearm unless the firearm or packaging carries a label that provides the number of the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Gun Suicide Preven-
- 5 tion Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. LABELING REQUIREMENT.
- 7 (a) Prohibition.—Notwithstanding the exclusion of
- 8 firearms from the definition of consumer product in sec-

tion 3(a)(5)(E) of the Consumer Product Safety Act (15) U.S.C. 2052(a)(5)(E)), it shall be unlawful for a manufacturer or retailer to sell or offer for sale any firearm that 4 does not meet the requirements of subsection (b). 5 (b) NATIONAL SUICIDE PREVENTION HOTLINE 6 LABEL.—A firearm meets the requirements of this subsection if a clear and conspicuous label is attached to the 8 firearm or appears on any packaging of the firearm and 9 on any descriptive material included with the firearm 10 that— 11 (1) is written in both English and Spanish; 12 (2) in English, reads "IF YOU OR SOMEONE 13 YOU KNOW IS CONTEMPLATING SUICIDE. 14 PLEASE CALL THE NATIONAL SUICIDE PREVENTION LIFELINE AT" followed by the 15 16 toll-free phone number of the National Suicide Pre-17 vention Lifeline, maintained by the Assistant Sec-18 retary for Mental Health and Substance Use under 19 section 520E-3 of the Public Health Service Act (42 20 U.S.C. 290bb-36c), or any successor to such toll-21 free number; and 22 (3) contains a yellow triangle containing an ex-23 clamation mark that appears immediately before the words "IF YOU" on the label. 24

- 1 (c) Enforcement.—A violation of the prohibition in
- 2 subsection (a) shall be treated as a violation of section
- 3 19(a) of the Consumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C.
- 4 2068). Any person who violates subsection (a) shall be
- 5 subject to the penalties set forth in section 20 and 21 of
- 6 such Act (15 U.S.C. 2069; 2070).
- 7 (d) Retailer Defined.—In this section, the term
- 8 "retailer" includes a dealer, as such term is definition in
- 9 section 921(a) of title 18, United States Code.
- 10 (e) Effective Date.—This Act shall take effect on
- 11 the date that is two years after the date of enactment of
- 12 this Act.
