To apply for your U.S. passport, you must:

- Submit your completed application, DS-11, to request the Passport Book, Passport Card, or both, or submit the Renewal form, DS-82, to renew your passport. The application forms DS-11 and DS-82 can be downloaded from our website: travel.state.gov.
- Submit your evidence of U.S. Citizenship (one of the documents listed below):
 - A certified copy of your birth certificate;
 - An original Certificate of Naturalization or Citizenship;
 - Original Consular Report of Birth Abroad; or
 - Previously issued, undamaged, U.S. passport.
- Submit one recent Passport Photo—2"x2". NO GLASSES in Passport Photos.
- Present Valid Photo Identification—Driver's License, State ID Card, current passport or Military ID and submit a photocopy of the front and back of that ID.
- Payment of passport fee: credit card or contactless payment (Apple/Google Pay)

U.S. Passport Book: Valid for international travel by land, air, and sea.

U. S. Passport Card: Valid when entering the United States from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean and Bermuda at land or sea ports of entry. **Not valid for international travel by air.**

Validity of Books or Cards: 10 years for adults (ages 16 and older)
5 years for minors (under age 16)

**With Routine Processing, your application will be processed within 4-6 weeks.
Expedite Processing (within 2-3 weeks) is available for an additional \$60 fee.**

Passport applicants must appear in person, including minors. Passport applications for minors under 16 require the consent of **both** parents, or evidence that one parent has sole legal custody. 1-2 Day Delivery	Paid per application for 1-2 day delivery of an issued passport book from the Department of State to the customer. Only applies to mailing addresses within the United States. 1-2 day delivery is not valid for passport cards.	\$22.05
File Search Fee	A file search is necessary when an applicant is unable to present evidence of U.S. citizenship or verification of a previously issued U.S. Passport or Consular Report of Birth Abroad. Applicant must submit Form DS-11 and written request for a file search.	\$150
